• INTRODUCTION

On the occasion of our College Day, with great pride I would like to share with you the success of our students and the experience in achieving them. As I look back, it's an honor that this academic year 2021-2022 has brought us many accomplishments.

• STUDENTS

In our college, we have 513 students on role. Among them 238 students are male, and 275 students are female. There are 47 students in B.SC, 246 in B.Com General, 48 in B.Com Vocational and 172 in BBA. In this academic year, the college has admitted 16 students to B.Sc, 54 students to BBA, 65 students to B.Com (G), and 17 students to B.Com (V). 41 boys and 14 girls are accommodated in the hostel.

RESULTS OF SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER 2021 EXAMINATIONS

The overall result of the academic year 2021-22 was good. In final B.Sc., 17 students appeared for the examination and achieved a 100% result. Among them, 12 (70.58%) students passed with I Class and distinction. In final BBA, 53 students have appeared for the semester examination, 50 passed (94.33%). Among them, 30 (56.60%) students passed with first class and distinction. In final B.Com, among 124 students who have appeared for the examination, 117 students have passed (94.35%). Among them, 74 (59.67%) students passed with first class and distinction.

Ms. Rose D'Silva 2018-21 batch, secured II Rank in B.Com September/October 2021University Examination and is the recipient of Gold Medal for securing highest marks(300/300) in the subject Financial Accounting of V and VI Semester B.Com Degree. She is also the recipient of 'Vanamalidas Gokuldas Charitable Trust Cash Prize' for securing highest marks in Hindi language I to IV semester. The Management, Principal, Staff members, and Student of Dr. NSAM First Grade College congratulate her on this occasion.

We also appreciate the hard work put forth by all the students and concerned teachers to make such high results possible. Among the 192 students who have appeared for the Final Year degree examinations during Sep/Oct 2021, 89 students have enrolled and currently studying their Post-Graduation and 30 students were placed in the campus recruitment have been working at various places.
