He said that the Management in Japan was possible due to 3Ds: Determination, Dedication and Dignity. He also said that he wants to add one more 'D' i.e., Discipline. He mentioned that in Japan, Discipline and Punctuality are much honoured. In 2018, there was an agreement between Japan and India to send five lakh engineers in 5 years from India to Japan. Unfortunately, because of COVID, it never happened for the last three years. Now the latest requirement for Japan is ten lakh engineers from India.
