Annual Report 2015-2016

Dr. Nitte Shankara Adyanthaya Memorial First Grade College Nitte is pleased to present its Annual Report for 2015-16. Our college is built on the energy and drive of its people. This year is special since we have been re-accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade for consecutively two times. We have successfully achieved the majority of the objectives established at the beginning of the year by being innovative and focused, while keeping an eye on quality, efficiencies and excellence in execution. Our college is committed to a diverse range of experiences in and out of the classroom. This report highlights significant efforts across campus promoting diversity in campus events, programmes and course curriculum. The Sports, NSS and Cultural and other cells continues to provide support for multicultural activities at the college and has implemented a broad range of initiatives to enhance diversity on the college.

Our college takes great pride in providing students with a variety of activities within the classroom and also outside activities that emphasizes the rich variety of culture.

We believe the accomplishment of the objectives identified in this report will continue our current momentum, allowing us to continue to deliver seamless, personalized learning to students as we enhance agility and creativity within the College.

Here is the brief mention of some of the major events and achievements of this year.

Students and Faculty:

We have 535 students on roll now, of which 245 are boys and 290 are girls. B.Sc 36, BBM 136 and B.Com 363 students. Of the total strength about 55% are girls.

We admitted in this academic year for B.Sc course 14 students, BBM - 49 and B.Com - 129 students.

Results of April/May 2015:

Overall results were good. In Final BBM, out of 65 students 60 have passed making it 92.3%. Out of them, 27 have passed with distinction and 14 with First class. In Final B.Com, out of 79

students, 71 have passed making it 90%. Out of them 62 students passed with distinction and 6 with First class

The overall pass percentage is 91% in I year B.Com. and 95 % in the II year B.Com in all subjects. In I year BBM, 74% and II year BBM, 81% passed in all subjects. In I B.Sc 86% and in II B.Sc 100 % passed in all subjects.

We appreciate the hard work put in by all the students and teachers concerned to make such high results possible.

Staff:

We have 24 teaching staff and 14 non-teaching staff, 4 teachers with Ph.D. degree, 9 teachers have teaching experience of over two decades, 4 teachers have experience over 6 years. Ms. Shubha Gowri and Mr. Pramod Kumar, Department of Languages, Ms. Preethika, Department of Commerce and Management and Ms. Nisha Shetty, Department of Computer Science left the College for better prospects.
